CLASS INFORMATION

PRIMI PASSI (Age 3 & under)

This "parent & me" class combines arts & crafts, singing, movement, story time & games to encourage a love for the language from a very young age.

Material Fee: To be determined by instructor and payable to the instructor on the first day of classes.

PICCOLI AMICI (Age 4 to 6)

This is a *child-only* class that focuses on vocabulary, conversational and early literacy skills through games, arts and crafts, stories, songs and imaginative play.

Material Fee: To be determined by instructor and payable to the instructor on the first day of classes.

PARLO ITALIANO I, Beginner (Age 7 to 12)

PARLO ITALIANO II, Intermediate (Age 7 to 12)

Organized around theme-based units, songs, interactive exercises and games, this course emphasizes communicative abilities and vocabulary building as well as listening, reading, writing, pronunciation and basic grammar skills.

Material Fee: To be determined by instructor and payable to the instructor on the first day of classes.

ADULT CLASSES

Organized around theme-based units and authentic materials, our classes for adults emphasize communicative abilities and vocabulary building, as well as listening, reading, pronunciation and grammar skills. Aspects of contemporary Italian life and culture are introduced through interactive exercises.
